CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT - BIRCH CLASS

Birch class have been really good scientists this half term. They really enjoyed our whole school science day where they took part in a range of experiments. We made rafts and chopped apples to observe the changes over time. The children also made rockets in a workshop all about space with Dr Foster which they are really proud of. In our science lessons, our topic has been materials and the children have been testing for rigidity and durability. We have been exploring the term 'fair test' and making sure all of our experiments have fair results.













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RE curriculum and parental support

All schools must provide RE to all registered pupils, including those in Reception. Although not part of the National Curriculum, RE forms part of the statutory Basic Curriculum, which all schools must follow. Whilst all schools must provide RE to their pupils, only Maintained and Voluntary Controlled schools are required to teach RE in accordance with their Locally Agreed RE Syllabus. As a maintained school we follow the Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus which teaches children about the main religions. We use the PlanBee resources to support us teach this syllabus.
