### CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT— CEDAR CLASS

Cedar class have been very busy. They presented a class assembly on the Earth and Planets to the rest of the school, parents and friends. They spoke confidently, expressively and loudly enough for all to hear. The presentation was a combination of poems, facts, role play and songs.







For RE, the children learnt about the Jewish festival of Sukkhot. The children learnt about why the festival is celebrated, then prepared a typical meal which the children ate.



In our latest Science topic, the children, as scientists, investigated air resistance. They made parachutes of different sizes then tested them from a height to see which parachutes took the longest to land. The children found that the bigger the parachutes, the longer the parachute took to land. This is because there was more air resistance.



In English, the children have been studying the text, 'The London Eye Mystery'. They have been identifying new vocabulary that they will use to write a police report. In Mathematics, the children have been learning about fractions, in particular, how to find equivalent fractions and add and subtract fractions with different denominators.
