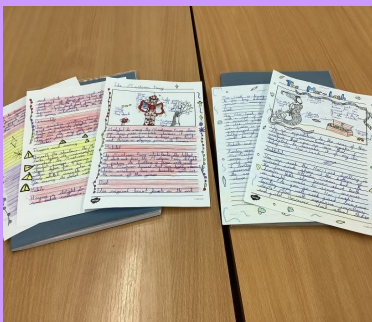
I hope you have a great half term break and look forward to welcoming you back to school on Monday 24th February.
