

# CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT - Birch Class








In Birch class this week we have been working on using doubles and near doubles in maths. Here you can see the children using numicon to aid their learning.

There is no guarantee that they will make any changes but I believe it is worth asking and if we have a good response to the survey we may have a better chance.


