This term we have been very busy; getting used to our new routines, making new friendships and best of all, learning through play!

This week we have been reading the story, 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. It's about a family who go on an adventure through swishy swashy grass and swirling whirling snowstorms in order to try and find a bear, and when they do they run all the way home to hide under the duvet.

The book has lovely rhyme and sounds that we have been practicing in our phonics, such as trudging through the mud, "squelch, squerch". We drew pictures of bears to practice our observation skills, looking closely at pictures of bears and then drawing what we see; "two big furry ears, two big googly eyes, one wet shiny nose...IT'S A BEAR!" In our maths we have been learning about prepositions, where an object is. We looked through the story to see where the bear was; behind a tree, on the hill or in the cave.

Each week we enjoy a new story and a new nursery rhyme in our rhyme time. This week we have been singing "Incy Wincy Spider". We used musical instruments to create different sound effect for the rhyme such as tapping claves for climbing up the spout and using rain sticks to wash the spider out.
