They received their badges and left wearing them with pride. Their first job is to identify some strategies on how to improve attendance across the school. I am looking forward to hearing their ideas.



CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT—HAZEL CLASS

Year 2 are now fully settled into the routine of school and are still enjoying taking part in a range of learning opportunities.

In English, we have begun to expand our sentence writing by using conjunctions 'and' and 'but'. The children had the opportunity to role play and create longer sentences by using conjunctions. Once the sentences were in the right place, i.e. capital letters at the start, full stop at the end and a conjunction in the middle, the children then joined hands to show that they have created a longer sentence.



In history we have been learning more about the period of The Great Fire of London. We now know that this was during the Tudor times. So, we looked more closely at how Tudor houses were built and the materials they were made from. We then drew our own Tudors houses and annotated each part.


