In order for these high expectations to be achieved we ask you to address the following issues with your child's uniform today.

1.	Dark grey skirt or dark grey trousers	
2.	White polo shirt with or without school logo	
3.	Red sweatshirt or cardigan with or without school logo	
4.	Completely black shoes or completely black trainers (no logo)	
5.	Summer months: Red checked dresses (with white socks) or dark grey shorts (with white or grey socks)	
6.	Red polo shirt with or without school logo	
7.	Black shorts	
8.	Black or white trainers (different to black uniform footwear)	
9.	Black or navy tracksuit for outside PE during cold weather	

The following items were missing or incorrect:

Sensible black footwear should be worn. (If the footwear requires laces, these should be black too.) Black trainers without logos are acceptable.

Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct uniform within the next couple of days or by Monday of the next week if you need to order items of clothing from Smarty Schoolwear, <u>www.smartyschoolwear.co.uk</u>.
